GRANT HIGHLIGHT



The Seward Community Library and Museum received a \$597 mini-grant to develop Discovery Kits to provide children the opportunity to explore STEAM concepts through reading, creativity, and hands-on activities. The kits allow

families to learn, explore and play at home to foster a lifelong interest and understanding of STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math) concepts.

The Discovery STEAM kits are divided into general categories of physical science, life science, arts & music, and technology. Each kit will contain at least two books, hands-on exploration supplies, a brochure, a lesson plan/instructions/worksheet, a notebook to record tips or comments for future users, and a short survey, all stored in a convenient clear plastic bin.

Libraries across the country are adding STEM, STEAM, or Discovery-style kits to their collections, including the Anchorage Public Library, which has 88 STEM kits. With the funds granted, the Seward Community Library and Museum was able to add ten kits covering topics such as Dinosaurs and Fossils, Animal Tracks, Origami, Rocks & Minerals, and even Robots! They have plans to create and add 40 more kits in the future.
