Pass! With the awarding of this year's major grants worth \$71,130, the Seward Community Foundation has now awarded over ONE-MILLION dollars in grants to Seward and Moose Pass nonprofits.

SCF's eleven endowed funds have

grown to 3.7 million dollars. Earnings have provided 452 grants to 67 different organizations in Seward and Moose Pass. The Seward Senior Center, He Will Provide Food Pantry, Seward Area Hospice, SOS Pets, Boys and Girls Club, Seward Arts Council, Moose Pass Library, Seward Little League, Bear Creek Fire Department, and many others have received funding from Seward Community Foundation.

SCF Awards \$71, 160 to Local Nonprofits in May

Seward PTA \$9,420 for Kids to Slopes

This fantastic program takes 125 Seward Middle schoolers to Alyeska to develop positive peer-to-peer relations, build self confidence, and learn to ski and rip

turns on the slopes! Funded by the Seward Wellness Fund, the Larson Family Fund, the Dieter Family Fund for the Prevention of Domestic Violence and Teen Suicide, and the SCF Fund.



Independent Living Center \$4,000 for T.R.A.I.L.S. 2022

This grant will help Independent Living Center participants to enjoy outdoor recreation activities this summer in a safe and fun environment. Funded by the SCF Fund.



Moose Pass Volunteer Fire Department \$12,277 for Emergency Radios

Replacing old radios with new equipment will be real-
